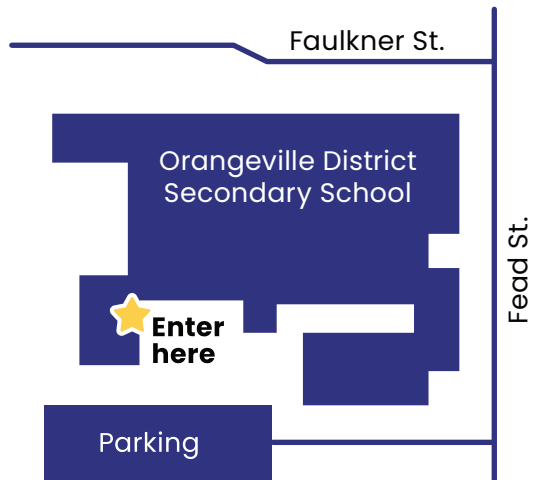


Entertainment events
